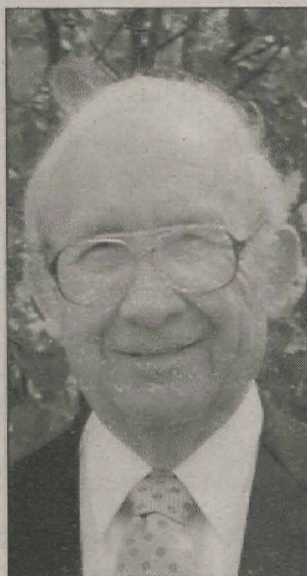

Jobe Harrison Bowen, 96, of Eden Terrace, formerly of Wilson; died Tuesday, Dec. 15, 2009 at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center.

Born April 3, 1913, in Surry County, he was the son of the late John Wesley and Louella Kiger Bowen, and the husband of the late Evie Evon Holland Bowen. A graduate of Pilot

Mountain High School in Pilot Mountain, he was retired from the Internal Revenue Service. He was a U.S. Army Air Force Veteran of World War II and a member of Forest Hills Baptist Church in Wilson, where he was a former deacon and treasurer.
