The Cultural Program will begin October 6, 1969 with a new view point and a revised program. It will try to involve as many youth as possible. A new method will be used to present the program.

The Cultural program will be working closely with the Africana Art Gallery.

The Youth Board representatives will hold a meeting in their areas in order to inform the youth and the community about the program. Parents are also asked to attend this meeting. The youths will fill out an information sheet which will include the following information: Name, age, address, school attending, parents' name number of brothers and sisters, and what areas of the program they are interested in.

There will also be tutoring sessions. If your child needs help, you may indicate what subjects he is having difficulty in.

in Youths will be admitted in the centers only if they are interested in the areas that they indicate. The Black History sessions will be open to all youths.

We hope that with this new program you will work with us more and attend some of the sessions and meeting to see what the youth program is all about and what your child is doing.

IMPORTANT: All youths are encouraged NOT to come to the centers when they are supposed to be in school. They are to attend school regularly and not hang out at the centers. The centers will be opened from 4:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.

All art classes will be held at the Africana Art Gallery. You will receive Factsheets twice a month which will tell you about the activities of the Youth centers. You will be invited to attend special programs at the centers. There will be programs especially for parents.
