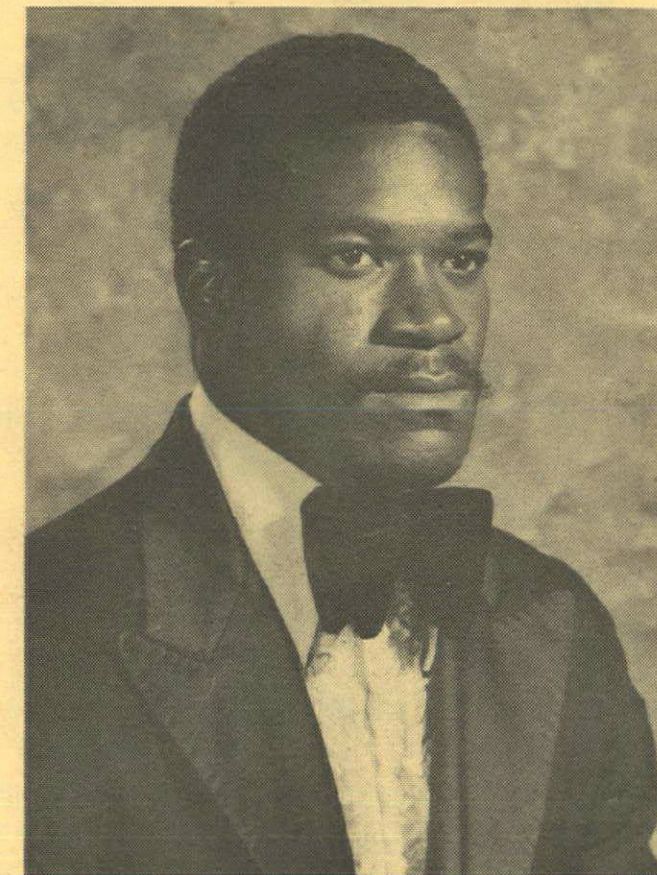

JAMES MICHAEL PAIGE

James Michael Paige, son of the late James Arthur Paige and Cara Mason Paige, his adoptive parents, was born on May 7, 1954, in Sanford, North Carolina. He departed this life on Sunday, July 22, 1979, at High Point, North Carolina.

"Mike" attended the Chatham County Public Schools, graduating from Jordan-Matthews High School in 1972. In the fall of that year, he enrolled in A & T State University and gained an athletic scholarship (football), graduating in June, 1977, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration.

"Mike" was an athlete - a well-rounded all-American personality - in athletics, socially, in civic affairs, and in his personal and business interests. As a Boy Scout, his achievements span from Cub Scout to Eagle Scout. While in public school, Mike was a member of the Monogram Club, the high school band, a star participant on the track and football teams. He participated in the High School High I. Q. Bowl, served as County-wide Student Council President, and was a member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, and a member of the Editorial Staff of the high school newspaper.

At A & T State University, "Mike" was a member of the varsity football team (Number 93), serving as outside linebacker. He was also a member of the Business Club.

He was a member of The Light of The World Lodge # 711, F and A.M., Siler City, North Carolina. He was also a member of Council Number 1668, Order of the Saint Luke, serving as President of the Juvenile Department.

"Mike" was a lifetime member of Lamberts Chapel Baptist Church, he served in many capacities within the Sunday School Department and as a member of both the Junior Choir and the Male Chorus.

Surviving are his mother, Mrs. Cara Mason Paige, and a son, Cedric Price, both of Siler City, North Carolina.
