



REV. LUCIUS J. JEFFERIES was born May 21, 1922 in Cherokee County, SC to the late Rev. Daniel and Deaver Jefferies. He went from labor to reward on October 26, 1994. His early education was received in the Cleveland County School Systems. He professed Christ at an early age and joined Young Grove Baptist Church where he served faithfully until he moved to Lee County and became a member of New England AME Zion Church.

He was called into the ministry in 1958 and was ordained an itenary elder in the year of 1972.
