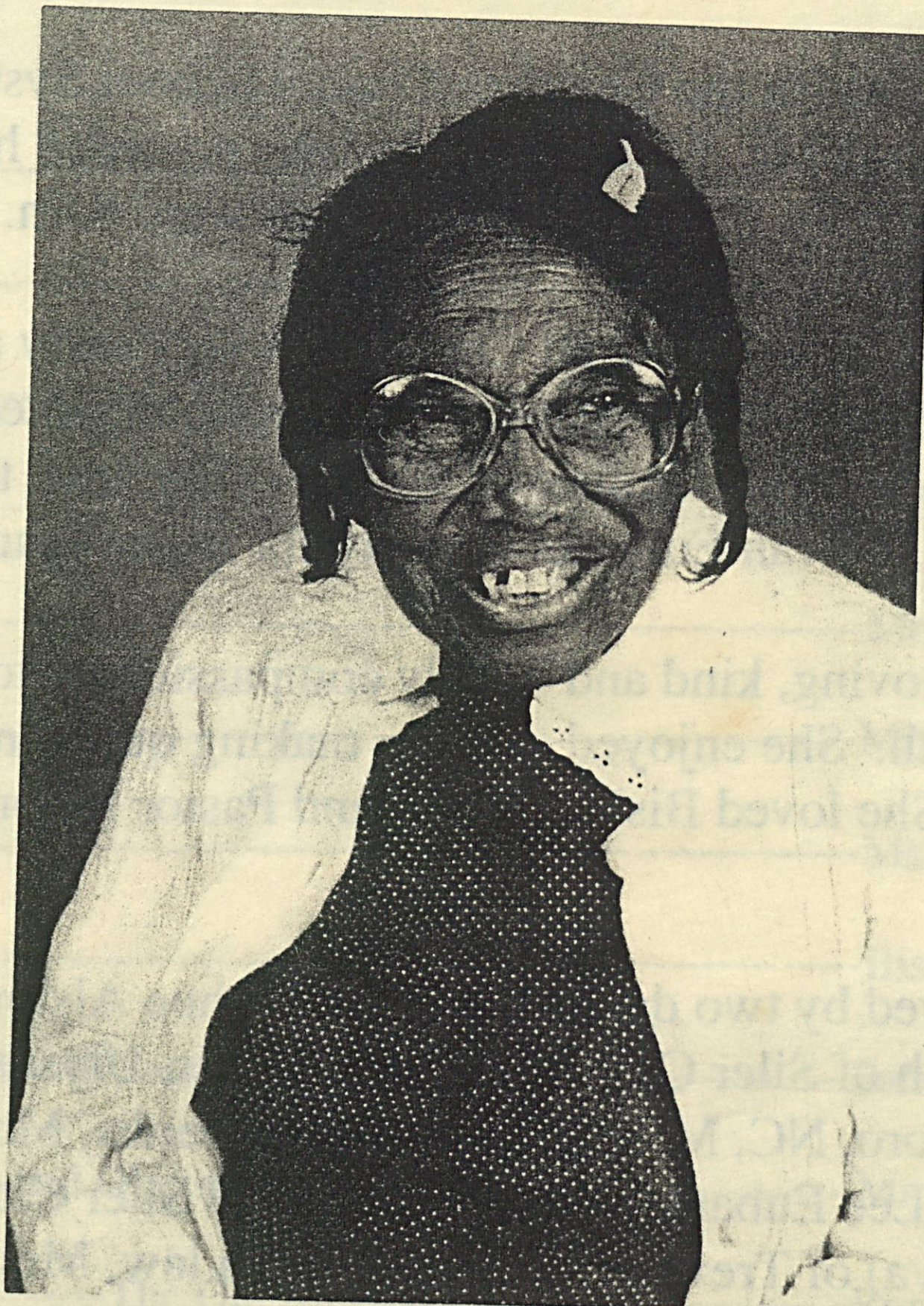

The Obituary
