She was united in holy matrimony to Mr. Richard Paschal; to this union two children were born.

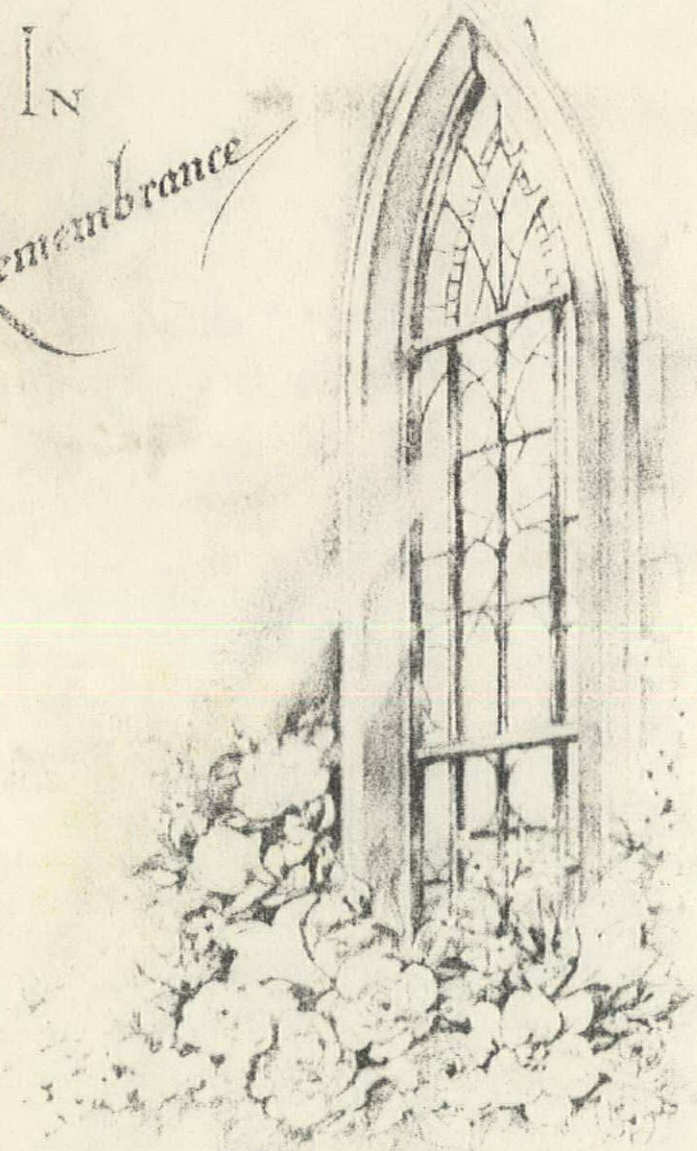
A kind and loving wife, a devoted mother, and an especially caring daughter who spent many hours caring for the family — she always carried a smile to everyone she met.
