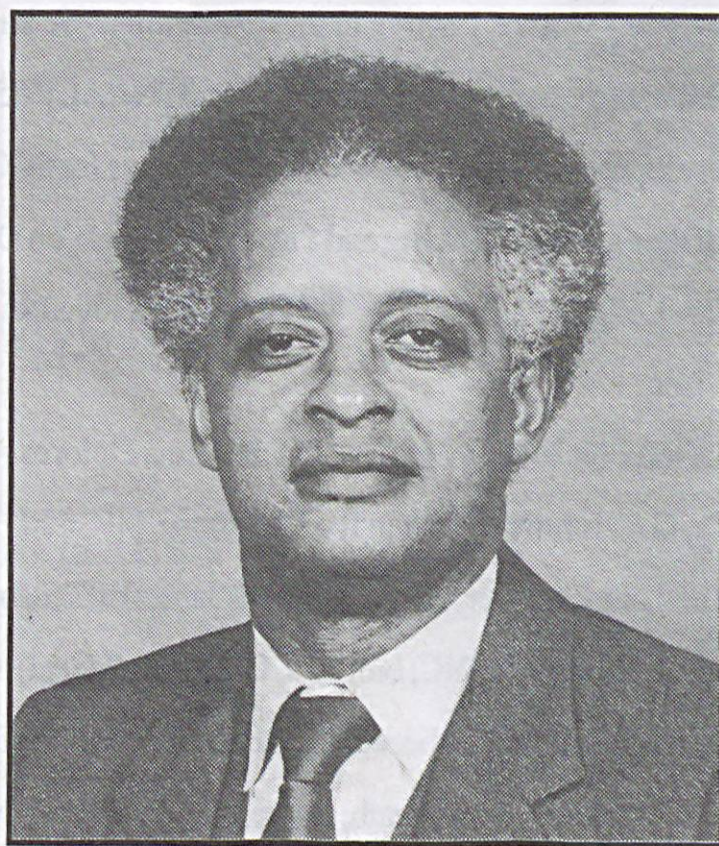

# Obituary

Brother Jimmy Minter Perry, son of Allie P. Baker, was born in Chatham County on December 11, 1942. He departed this life on October 23, 1999.

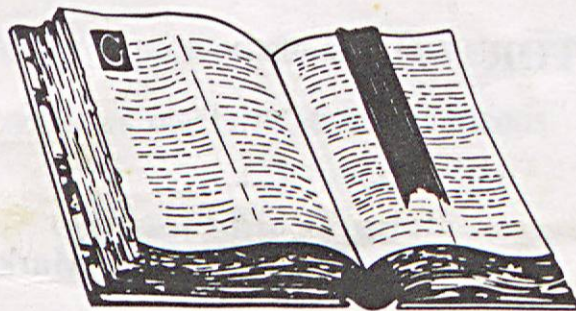
