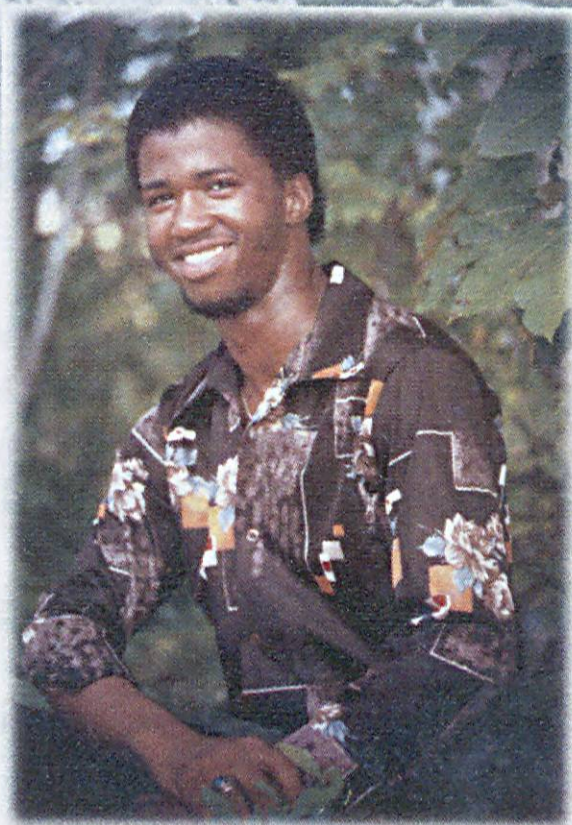

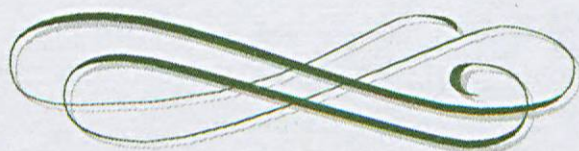
Obituary

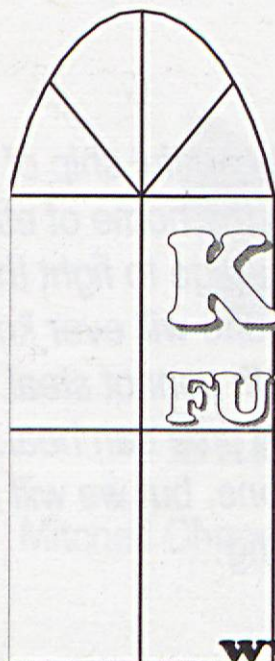
