That the Secretary of this Grand Lodge be directed to have the same printed with the abstract of the proceedings of this Grand Annual Communication, and transmitted by him to the respective Lodges under the jurisdiction of this Grand Lodge.

Resolved unanimously, That the thanks of this Grand Lodge be presented to the most worshipful John Louis Taylor, Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of North-Carolina & Tennessee, for the able, eloquent & instructive address delivered to the Grand Lodge this day.— That he be requested to furnish a copy of said address ; and that the same be printed and distributed to the several Lodges under the jurisdiction of this Grand Lodge.

Whereas it frequently happens that some of the Members of the Grand Lodge and Visitors, appear in the same not prepared with the necessary Masonic clothing. In order, therefore, that such Brethren may be accommodated in future, and the Lodge when convened, have a more uniform appearance.

Resolved, That the most worshipful Grand Master be requested to purchase or have made such number as he may deem necessary, of plain aprons and sashes, for the use of the Grand Lodge ; that he draw upon the Grand Treasurer for the amount, who is hereby required to pay the same.

Whereas Royal Edwin, No. 5, Windsor, St. John, No. 13, Duplin County ; St. Tammany, No. 16, Martin County, have been informed by the Secretary of this Grand Lodge to appear at this Grand Annual Communication, and shew cause why their charters should not be arrested, and said Lodges be dissolved : And whereas the said Lodges, respectively, have failed to appear : Therefore it is resolved that the Charters of said Lodges be arrested and that they be from henceforward dissolved : That the Secretary of this Grand Lodge call up-

on them for their funds, furniture and jewels, according to the Constitution of this Grand Lodge.

Resolved, That the Secretary of this Grand Lodge give information to St. John, No. 4, Kingston, American George, No. 17, Murfreesborough; Jerusalem, No. 35, Carteret County; Friendship, No. 36, Fort Barnwell; Hiram, No. 40, City of Raleigh, to appear by Delegates, at the next Annual Communication of this Grand Lodge, and shew cause, if any they have, why their Charters shall not be arrested, and said Lodges dissolved, for the non-payment of dues, and for their negligent conduct in not sending a copy of thir proceedings to this Grand Lodge, accompanied with a list of their Members as likewise a Delegation.

Resolved, That it be recommended by this Grand Lodge to the several Lodges of the State of Tennessee working under its jurisdiction, that they in future pay particular attention to the establishing of a certain fund in their respective Lodges, to answer the charities that may be required of them, and the dues they may owe to this Grand Lodge. Some of these Lodges having been found deficient in settling their accounts with this Grand Lodge, owing as it is suggested, to a want of proper care in establishing such fund.

And that the said Lodges be required to transmit to this Grand Lodge, from time to time as may be convenient, not less than once in every two years an abstract of their proceedings with a list of their officers and members.

The Grand Lodge proceeded to instal their Grand Officers for the ensuing year, which was done in ancient form of the usages of Masons: First the Grand Master was installed by the Deputy Grand Master for the last year; the Deputy Grand Master, the Grand Senior and G. J. Warden, Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer were installed by the most worshipful the Grand Master.

Resolved, That the most worshipful the Grand Master and the right worshipful Grand Senior Warden, be required to write Circular Letters to the subordinate Lodges, requesting payment of their dues, &c.

Resolved, That a Committee be appointed to inspect the Books and Accounts of the Grand Treasurer; which Committee shall report to this Grand Lodge at the next Annual Communication, stating the balance then in the hands of the Grand Treasurer, and the sums due the Grand Lodge, uncollected. It is further resolved, that the Grand Treasurer be directed to call on all former Grand Treasurers, and other officers for the sums, if any of which may remain in their hands due to this Grand Lodge.

Resolved, That Brother John C. Osborne, of St. John's Lodge, No. 3, Newbern, be requested to compile an edition of Himan Rezon, and submit the same to the inspection of the most worshipful Grand Master, the Deputy Grand Master, the Grand Senior, and the Grand

Junior Warden, and if approved by any two of them, that he publish the same, and furnish the Grand Lodge with 50 copies, for which he shall be paid his reasonable charge.

Resolved, That in addition to the sums allowed to Thomas Pound and John Wilson for their services as Tylers of the Grand Lodge, they be allowed the further sum of 40 shillings each, for services as Stewdars, in procuring liquors and other refreshments for the Lodge during this Grand Communication.
