RALEIGH — William Mock Black, 69, of 3201 Landor Road, died Wednesday, January 1, 1992. He was the District Manager of Armco Construction Products in the Carolinas and Virginia until his retirement in 1983. Mr. Black was a civil engineering graduate of Duke University and a past president of the Duke Engineering Alumni. He served as an officer in the U.S. Navy during World War II with the 110th "Seabees" unit. Mr. Black was active in the First Presbyterian Church and served as deacon and elder.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday from the First Presbyterian Church. Burial will be at Oakwood Cemetery.

Surviving: his wife, Jane Jeter Black; one son, William M. Black Jr. and wife, Nancy Fountain Black of Raleigh; two brothers, David C. Black of Mt. Home, Tenn., and Robert Williams Black Jr. of Raleigh; two sisters, Robbie Sue Forbes of Wilson and Mary Anne Poston of Penney Farms, Fla.
