- Williard stated that his duty stations were: Germany, France, New Guinea, Philippines, Japan and returned to Fort Bragg, Jan 1946 where he was assigned to go out and pick up a soldier who was AWOL and escort him back to Fort Bragg. He served 3 years and 3 months of active duty.

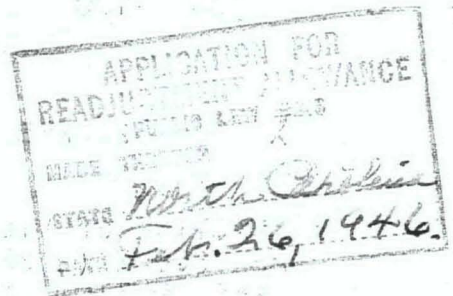
