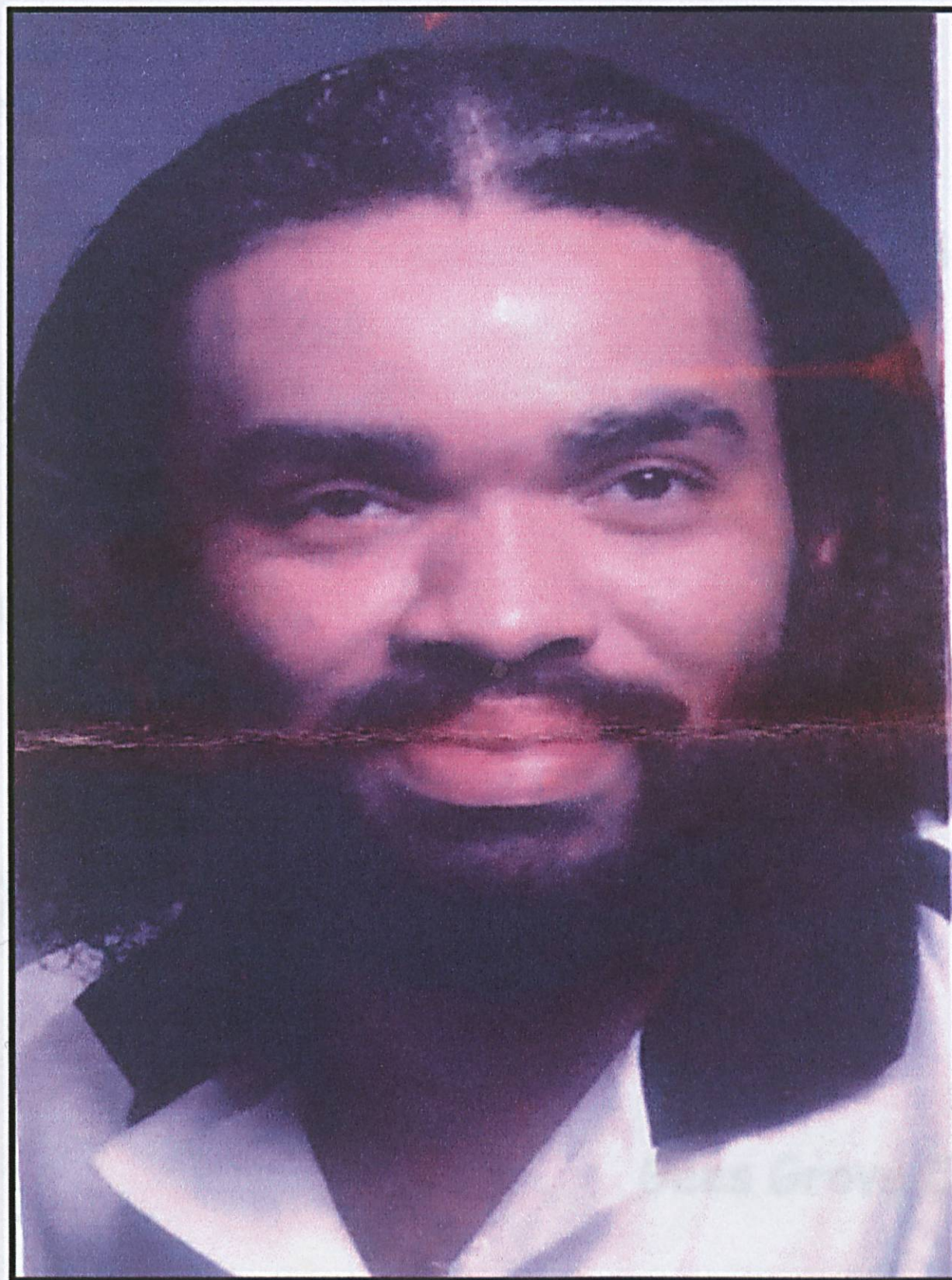

And His Promise Remains

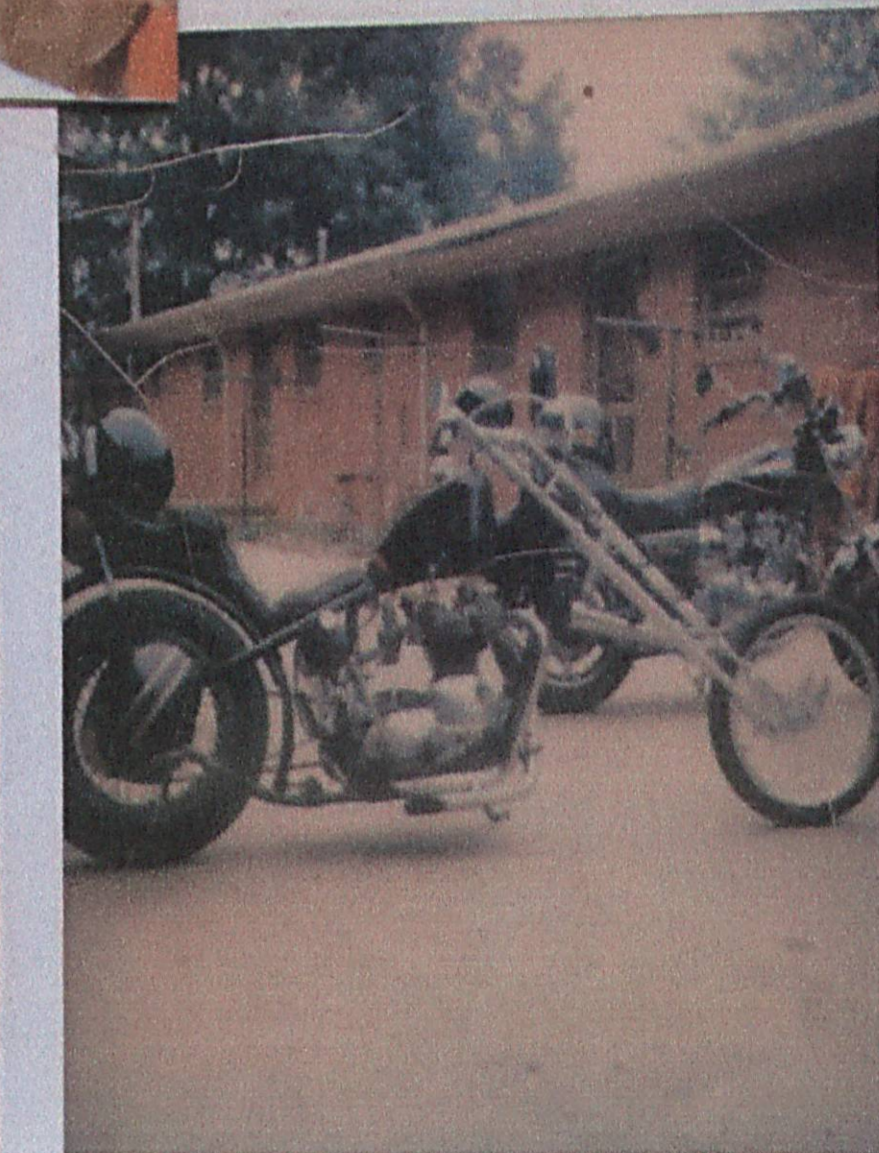
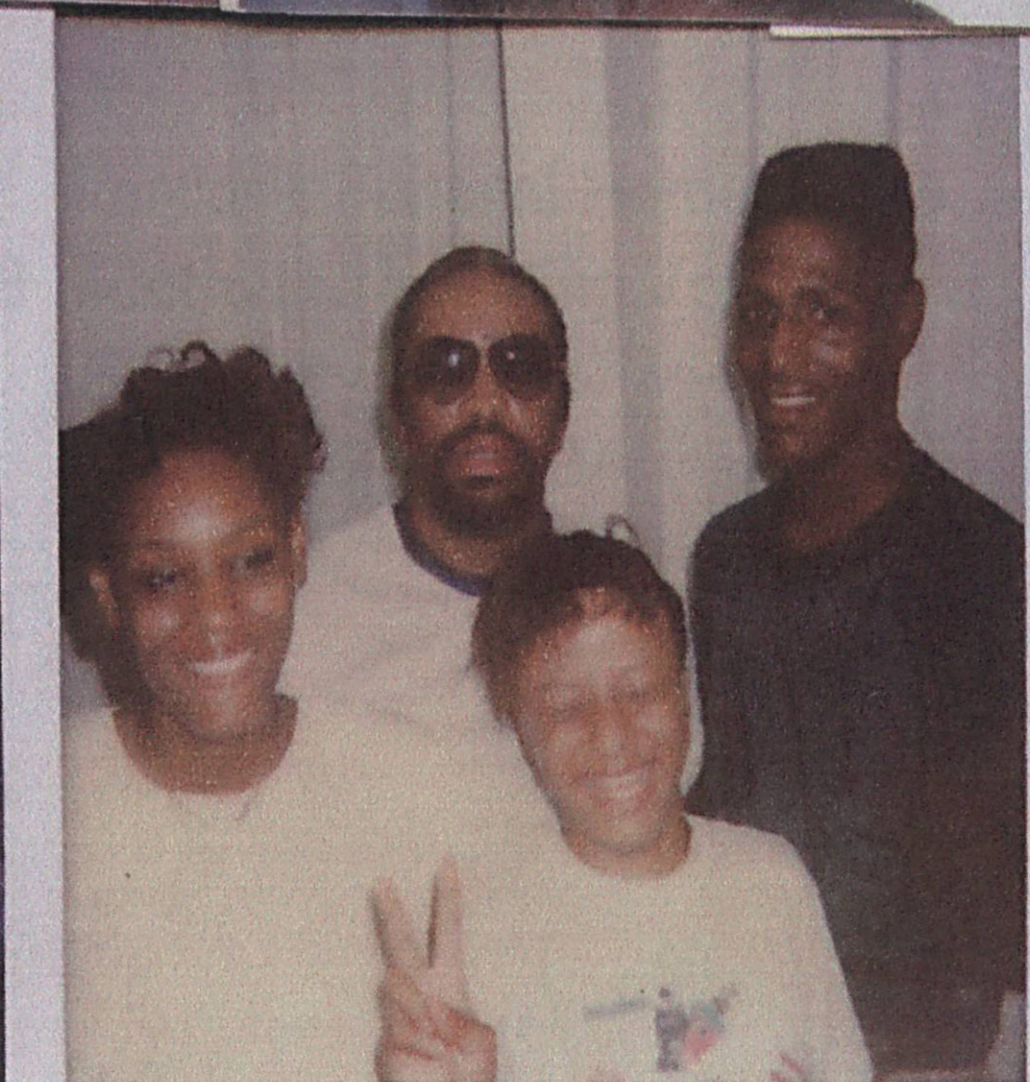
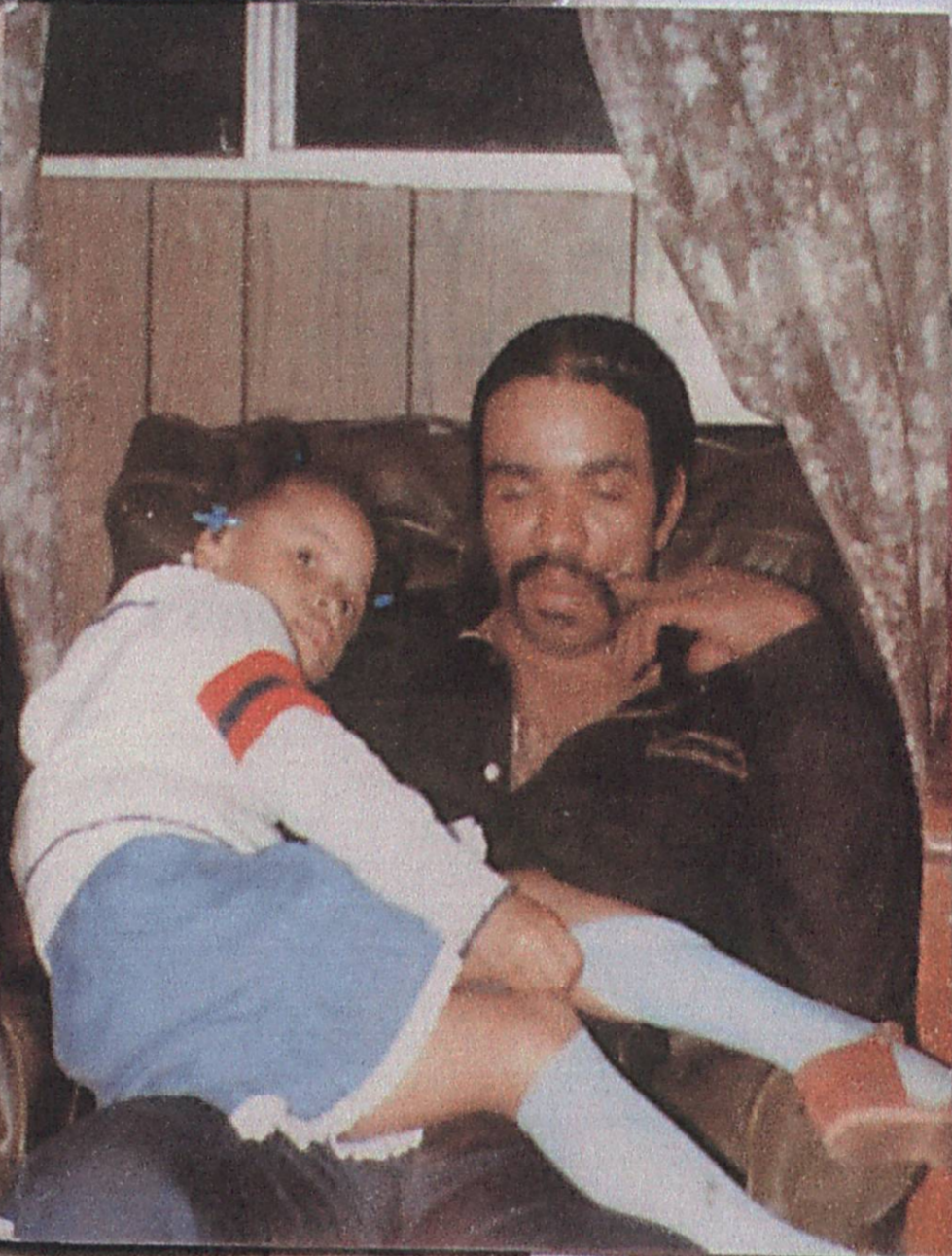
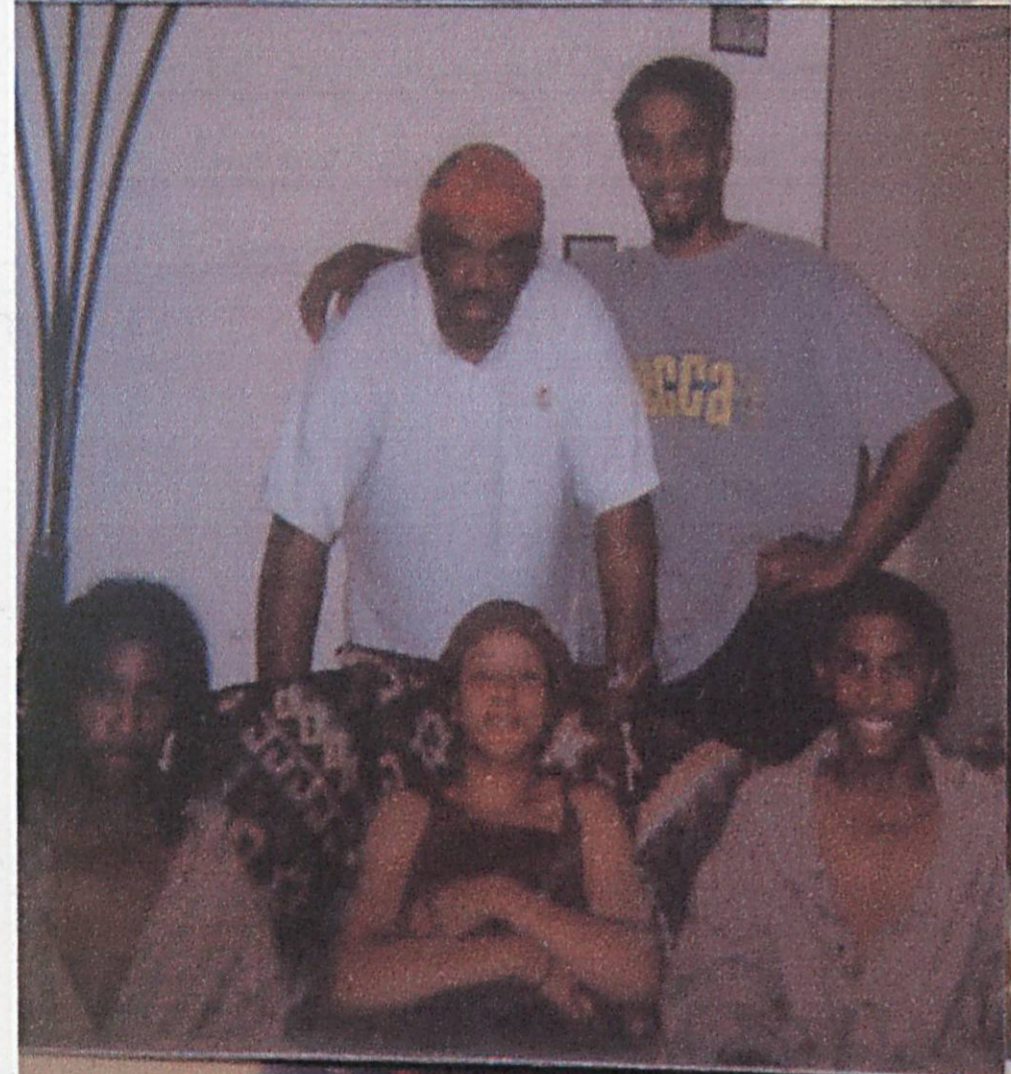
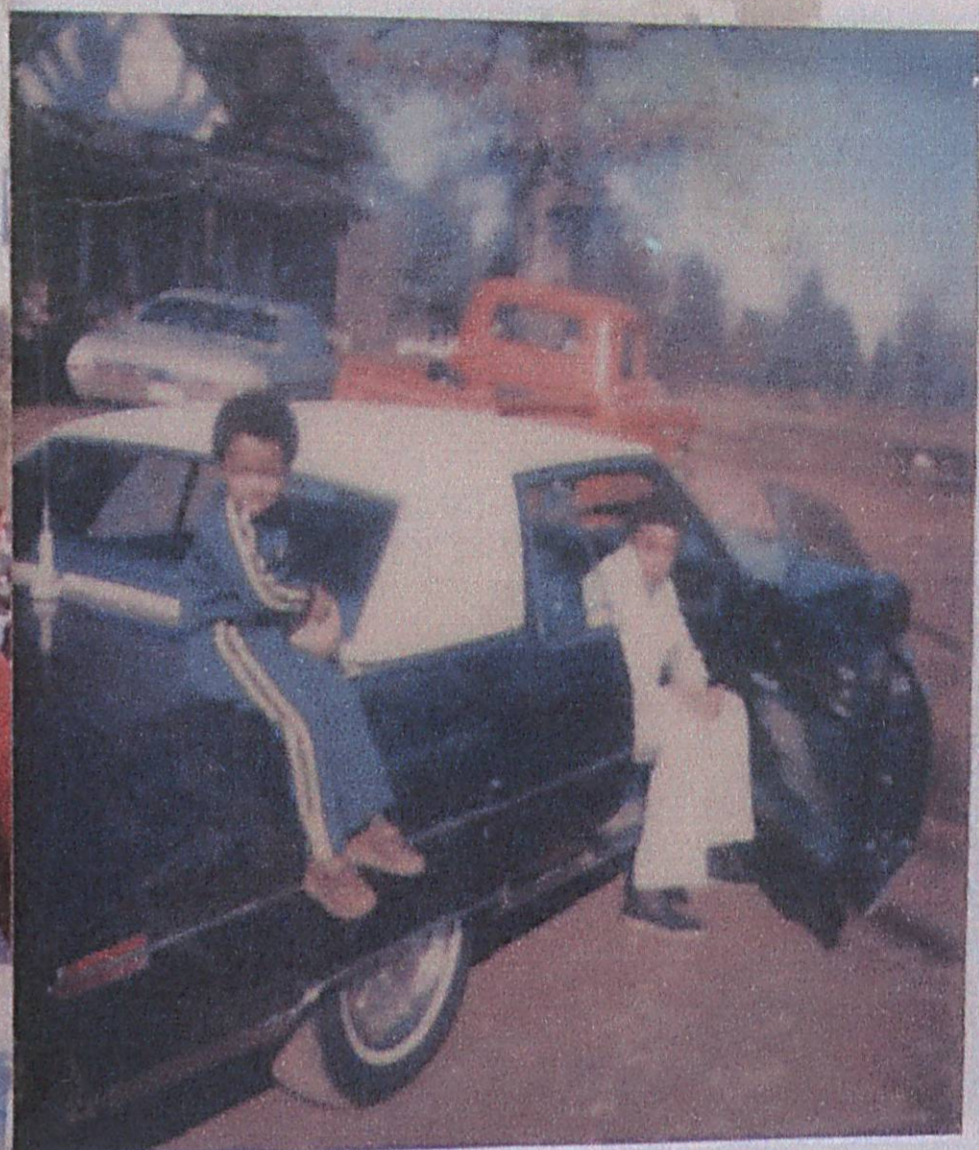
