SHE MARRIED (1) ARTHUR SHERWOOD MCKEEL 27 MAR 1932 IN EMPORIA, GREENSVILLE COUNTY, VA. HE WAS BORN 05 DEC 1909 IN WILSON COUNTY, NC, AND DIED JUL 1986 IN WILSON COUNTY, NC. SHE MARRIED (2) JOHN LEE LANCASTER 08 NOV 1946 IN CRAVEN Co., NC. HE WAS BORN 1907 IN CRAVEN COUNTY, NC, AND DIED ABT. 1964 IN CRAVEN COUNTY, NC.

NOTES FOR EVA BOYKIN:

EVA AND SHERWOOD HAD ONLY ONE CHILD WHICH DIED AT BIRTH. THEY DIVORCED 14 JUNE 1944 IN WILSON.

EVA AND JOHN HAD NO CHILDREN AND DIVORCE 21 NOV 1949 IN CRAVEN COUNTY, NC. EVA MARRIED A THIRD TIME ABOUT 1967 WHICH WAS ANNULLED SHORTLY THEREAFTER.

WHILE SERVING IN THE WAC, SHE OBTAINED THE RANK OF SERGEANT AND RECEIVING THE FOLLOWING DECORATIONS AND CITATIONS: 1) GOOD CONDUCT MEDAL, 2) VICTORY METAL, 3) AMERICAN THEATER RIBBON, 4) WAAC SERVICE RIBBON, 5) LAPEL BUTTON ISSUED 2 SEP 1945, AND 6) AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE CERTIFICATE IN 1946.
