No June German

Rocky Mount, May 23.—The war has been responsible for calling off Rocky Mount's 62nd annual June German.

President Harvey Roberts today announced that the officers of the Carolina Cotillion Club had decided at a meeting to call off the famous affair which has attracted thousands of dancers here from every state in the union.

Shortage of tires and gasoline, together with the fact that about half the club's active membership is serving in the armed forces were given as the reason for the decision.

The big dance was postponed only once before—in 1918.
