MOTHER DEAR IS ONLY SLEEPING.

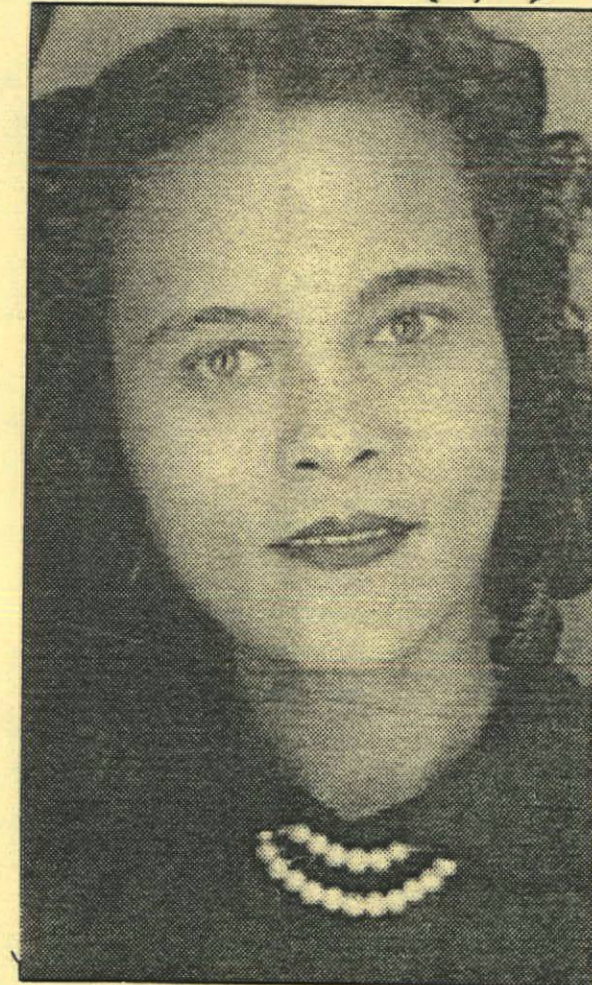
