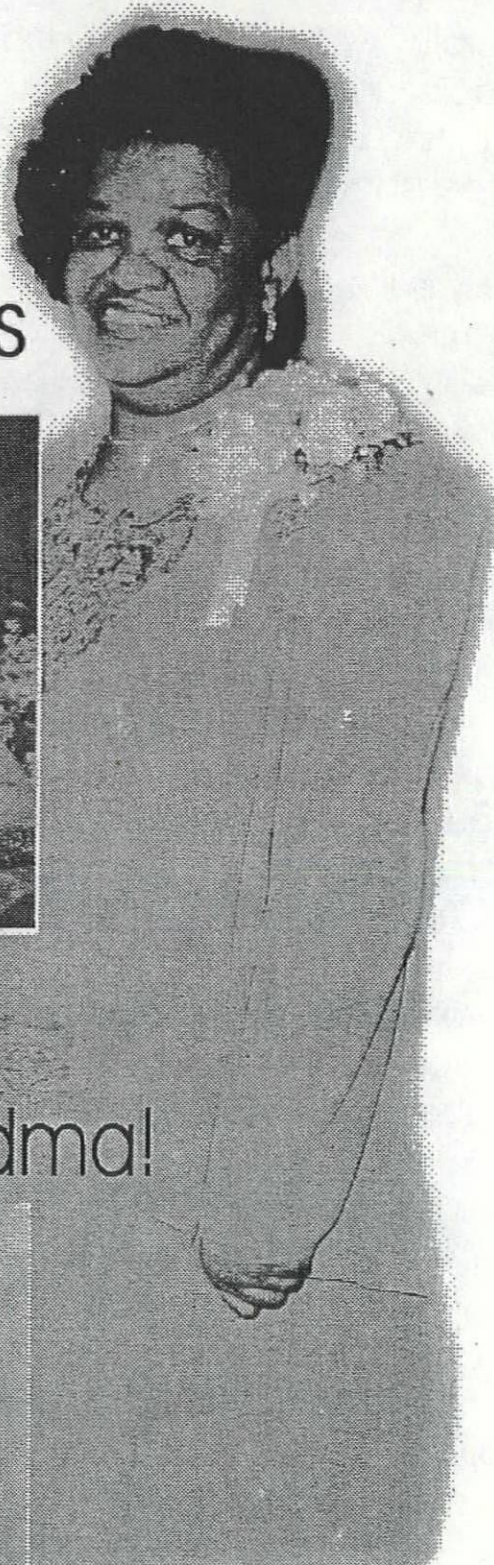

The Life of . . . Dorothy Brooks Ledwell 1943
