Robert Brewer, the son of the late Milas and Lou DeGraffenreidt Brewer was born February 28, 1890 in Chatham County. He departed this life Thursday Morning, October 8, 1970, being 80 years, 8 months and 10 days of age.

He joined Mitchell Chapel Church when a boy where he remained a member until his death. He was active as a member of the choir until ill health limited his activities. The congregation was often thrilled by the deep bass tone he added to the services.
