## OBITUARY

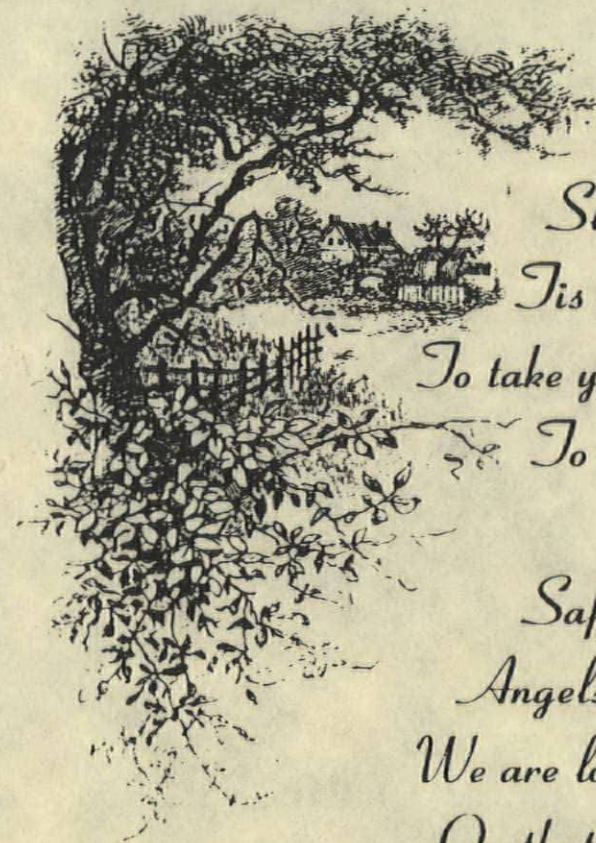
