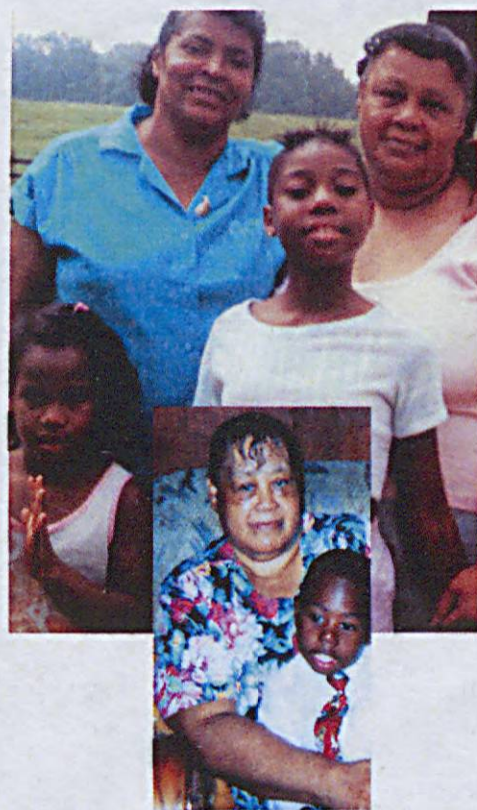
God saw I was suffering.
