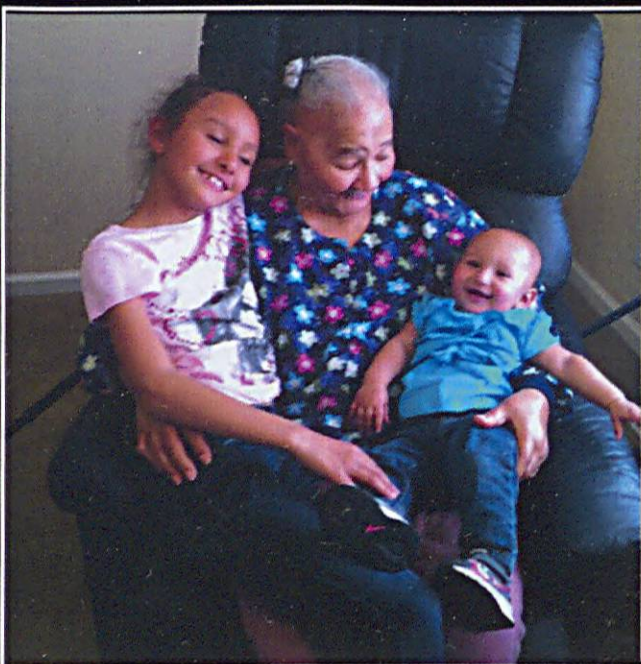
Grandma,

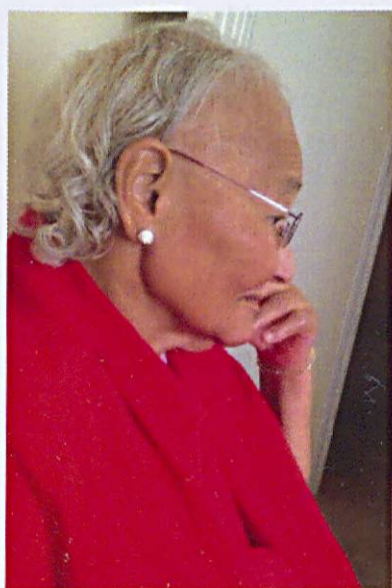

# Obituary

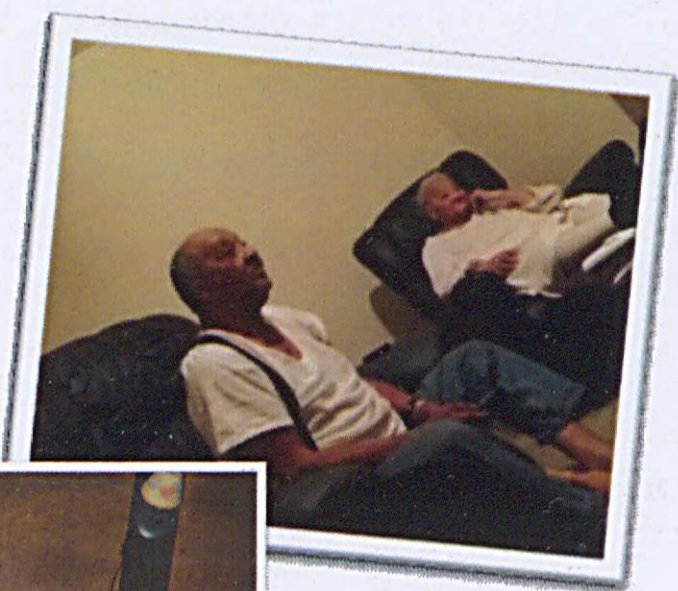
