In "Watchman of the South", February 1, 1844, describes it as "a brick wall about 6 feet long and 2 feet high, without any inscription his friend Captain Wilson, whose grave is nearby, found him plundered and stripped of every garment, and hastily placing him on his horse bore him to this place of sepulture. Congress voted a momment to the man most beloved in his country, a sacrifice to the public welfare, but - - - his grave is still without an inscription. The college bears his name".
