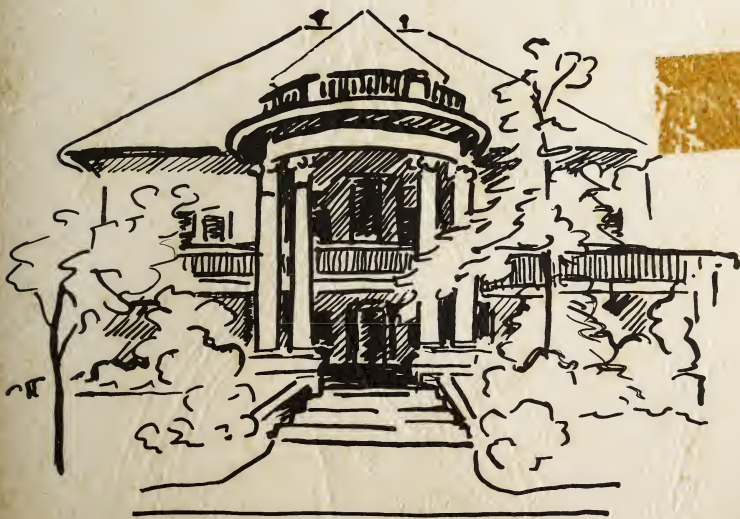

## THE AMERICAN'S CREED







## OUR CLUB HISTORY

Fifteen women representing various clubs and organizations of the city met, on April 25, 1919, with Miss Adelaide Fries in order to discuss with Mrs. Clarence Johnson, then president of The State Federation of Women's Clubs of North Carolina, the organization of a Woman's Club for Winston-Salem. The idea gained enthusiasm and on May 7, one hundred and seventy-five women answered the call for a mass meeting. This was held in The Board of Trade rooms on Liberty Street. With interest at a high peak, an organization was perfected with Mrs. Howard E. Rondthaler elected president and Mrs. Henry L. Riggins, vice-president.

The Y. W. C. A. very kindly offered the Club the use of their rooms until a club house could be secured.

In the first two years, the membership grew to 380. We needed larger quarters for the monthly meetings. The new Robert E. Lee Hotel proffered us the ballroom. In 1922, a lot on Fifth Street between Broad and Summit Streets was purchased for \$7,500, and paid for in 1923. Our present club house was bought from Mrs. Cicero Tise in 1925 for the amazing sum of \$67,500. We made a down payment of \$10,000 together with the Fifth Street lot, leaving \$50,000 to be paid in five years. Our club house was opened on May 24, 1925, with a Sunday Vesper Service. The enormous task began of raising \$5,000 plus interest and insurance each year. Every known way of money-raising was tried. It was the survival of the fittest. The older women who could not act as saleswomen dropped out and new members were almost afraid to come in.

In 1930, thirty-one people endorsed a note to borrow \$30,000 to pay off the indebtedness. In 1935, the load was more than the active members could carry. We were faced with the loss of our club house. Then the people of the community nobly came to our rescue. Twenty-two persons reduced the debt from \$23,700 to \$6,000 and the deed of title was transferred to the Winston-Salem Foundation. All this time, the intrest groups were functioning and the Woman's Club was taking her active part in community betterment. Much remodeling was done to the house making it more adequate for large meetings and for upstairs' renters. Since



1935, the club life has been one of enjoyment and out giving, receiving the benefits of the club, rather than a hand to hand struggle for its very existence.

July 25, 1946 was a "Red-Letter Day," as on that day The Woman's Club of Winston-Salem made its last payment on the debt and a session of rejoicing was held by the Board of Directors. We are now the happy owners of our club house.

In 1920 our Woman's Club federated with the State Federation and the National Federation of Women's Clubs, and enjoyed the privileges and inspiration of this fellowship until 1934, when the club debt had become such a burden that we relinquished our state and national membership. In 1945 we again took up membership in the State Federation of Women's Clubs and in the General Federation of Women's Clubs in the United States.

Our Woman's Club has developed the unique feature of having "Clubs within a Club." The large Thursday Morning Music Club is our Music Department and the large Garden Club is our Garden Department. Both of these "Clubs within a Club" are, in addition, federated in their respective State Organizations. The Tuesday Book Club is growing steadily and together with The Poetry Group form our Literature Department. The Wednesday and Friday Bridge Groups are flourishing. While Fine Arts is small and in its beginning, this interest bids fair to develop into an Arts Club.

In these latter years, we have striven towards and attained 100% rating in the general State Federation.

In the meantime and throughout the years, our Junior Club which is "our child," has grown and flourished and is leading the state in worth while activities. The Junior Club shares the club house with the Senior Club and we are proud indeed of their accomplishments.

Our dream for the future of our Woman's Club is that it shall be more generally used by the members as a centre, that it shall be always a rendezvous for newcomers to our city and become more of a social and educational centre in our community.

## RULES GOVERNING THE WOMAN'S CLUB

The hostess shall have charge of all house functions and shall give a monthly report to the Board of Directors.

All food and beverages served in the Club House shall be provided by the Club, prepared and served by the Club Hostess unless otherwise approved by the hostess.

All reservations for lunches must be in by 9:00 o'clock the day before the luncheon. No cancellations can be accepted after this time and must be paid for by the individual.

No reservations or cancellations shall be made through the Club Hostess.

The Club House is available for civic and social functions when they do not conflict with club programs as scheduled. All functions shall terminate by 11 P. M.

# **CONSTITUTION**

## **ARTICLE I**

### **Name**

This organization shall be known as The Woman's Club of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, Incorporated.

## **ARTICLE II**

### **Object**

The object of this Club shall be to promote and encourage education, literature, the sciences and arts; to take part in civic affairs affecting the public interest; and to participate in movements connected with the general welfare of the community.

## **ARTICLE III**

### **Membership**

Section 1. Membership in this Club shall be active and complimentary.

Section 2. Any woman of Winston-Salem and suburbs shall be eligible for membership.

## **ARTICLE IV**

### **Interest Groups**

The activities of this Club shall be conducted through Interest Groups.

## **ARTICLE V**

### **Officers**

The officers of this Club shall be: President; First Vice President; Second Vice President; Recording Secretary; Assistant Recording Secretary; Corresponding Secretary; Treasurer; Assistant Treasurer.

## **ARTICLE VI**

### **Board of Directors**

The Board of Directors of this Club shall be composed of the Officers, the Chairmen of Standing Committees, the Chairmen of Interest Groups and the President of the Junior Woman's Club.

## **ARTICLE VII**

### **Meetings**

The regular meetings of the Woman's Club, the Board of Directors, and the Interest Groups shall be held monthly except July and August.

## **ARTICLE VIII**

### **Affiliations**

Section 1. This Club is a member of the North Carolina Federation of Women's Clubs.

Section 2. This Club is a member of the General Federation of Women's Clubs.

Section 3. The title to the property of this Club is held for the benefit of the Club by the Winston-Salem Foundation.

## **ARTICLE IX**

This Constitution may be amended at any annual meeting by a two-thirds vote of those present, provided notice of the proposed amendment has been submitted in writing at a previous regular meeting of the Club.

## **BY-LAWS**

### **ARTICLE I**

#### **Membership**

Section 1. The application of a candidate for membership, signed by herself and two members recommending her, shall be presented to the Board of Directors. If approved by the Board her name shall be submitted to the Club (at a regular meeting) and upon the favorable action of a majority of those present, she shall be admitted to membership.

Section 2. Upon election the prospective member shall be notified by the Membership Chairman and asked to send her check to the Treasurer. Upon its receipt she will be mailed her membership card and upon its presentation shall be admitted to the privileges of Club membership.

Section 3. Complimentary membership shall be extended to the wives of all ministers of Winston-Salem and to the two women editors of the local press. Dues of the President of the General Club shall be remitted during her term of office.

Section 4. A member may withdraw from the Club only through written communication with the Board of Directors.

Section 5. A member may retain her membership in the Club even though she becomes a non-resident of Winston-Salem, if dues are paid currently. Lapse in dues shall call for cancellation of non-resident membership.

Section 6. A member of the Junior Woman's Club who is in good standing may be transferred to membership in the Woman's Club upon payment of current dues.

Section 7. A member may not invite a resident of Winston-Salem or suburbs to any monthly meeting, but may invite a non-resident. A resident may be invited once during the club year to the meetings of the Thursday Morning Music Club, Tuesday Book Club, Poetry Lovers Club, Art and American Home Department, and the Garden Department. The bridge groups

may invite a non-member substitute once during a series. Penalty for violation of this rule will be: First offense, reprimand by the Executive Board; Second offense, \$5.00 fine; Third offense, suspension from the club.

Section 8. Any member in good standing in the general club may visit any Interest Group, except the Federated Interest Groups, providing reservation for the luncheon be made in advance with the hostess chairman of that group. A member of the general club may visit a Federated Interest Group only once during the club year.

## **ARTICLE II**

### **Dues**

Section 1. The annual dues for active membership shall be ten dollars payable in April.

Section 2. The initiation fee shall be five dollars.

Section 3. The fiscal year shall begin Jan. 1 and end Dec. 31.

Section 4. Members entering the club after December 31 shall be admitted upon payment of five dollars and the initiation fee.

Section 5. A member wishing to resign from the Club must write a letter of resignation to the Club President in order to qualify for reinstatement.

A member who has resigned in good standing (i.e. dues paid) may be reinstated within three years without initiation fee upon the payment of her current dues.

Section 6. Transfer of members in good standing from other Federated Clubs will be accepted without payment of additional dues for the current year.

Section 7. After July 1, no member may attend club programs or enjoy the privileges of the club house until her dues for the ensuing year are paid. If, after receiving repeated notices from the Treasurer, her dues are not paid by the June meeting, she shall be declared delinquent and her name shall be summarily dropped from the club roster.

## **ARTICLE III**

### **Duties of Officers**

Section 1. The President shall preside at all regular meetings of the Club and Board of Directors and shall call all necessary special meetings. She shall, with the approval of the Board, fill vacancies occurring in office, appoint standing and special committees; countersign all orders on the Treasury; present a condensed narrative report of the year's work at the annual meeting; and report on the date designated by N. C. Federation of Women's Clubs, to the District President and to the Federation President, in accordance with instructions. She shall be ex-officio member of all Interest Groups. She shall act as chairman of the Board of Directors and shall submit its annual report. Expenses incurred by the Club President, when representing the Club in her official capacity, shall be reimbursed by the Club Treasurer upon the filing of expense account by the President. Mileage to be allowed on the basis of seven (7) cents per mile.



Section 2. The First Vice President and, in her absence, the Second Vice President shall perform all the duties of the President in her absence or disability. She shall be advisor to the Program Chairman.

Section 3. The Second Vice President shall be Chairman of the Entertainment Committee and shall have charge of all social affairs given by the Club.

Section 4. The Recording Secretary shall keep in permanent form the minutes of the meetings of the Woman's Club and of the Board of Directors. She shall also keep in separate form all amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws and all important decisions of the Board.

Section 5. The Assistant Recording Secretary shall perform the duties of the Secretary in her absence and such other duties as may be directed by the Secretary.

Section 6. The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct all correspondence of the Club and Board of Directors.

Section 7. The Treasurer shall collect all dues; hold and pay out all club monies subject to the order of the Board of Directors; issue all membership cards; and serve notice on all delinquents at the proper time. She shall make a report at each regular meeting of the Club and Board of Directors; and at the Annual Meeting, shall render a written report audited by the Finance Committee.

Section 8. The Assistant Treasurer shall perform the duties of the Treasurer in her absence and such other duties as may be directed by the Treasurer.

## **ARTICLE IV**

### **Board of Directors**

Section 1. Elected Officers, Interest Group Chairmen, Chairmen of Standing Committees and President of Junior Club shall constitute the Board of Directors. The Board shall meet the last Thursday of each month (except June and July) and on special call by the Club President. The President of the General Club shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall transact all business of the Club and report its proceedings at the regular Club meetings.

Section 3. Any five members of the Board may call the Directors together after the refusal of the President to issue such a call.

## **ARTICLE V**

### **Interest Groups**

Section 1. The work of the Club shall be conducted through Interest Groups. The Interest Groups shall be: Art and American Home Department; Thursday Morning Music Club; Tuesday Book Club; Poetry Lovers Group; Garden Department; Duplicate Bridge and Contract Bridge.



Section 2. The officers of each Interest Group shall be: Chairman; Vice-Chairman; Secretary; Treasurer. Term of office will be for two years.

Section 3. Each Interest Group Chairman will appoint a nominating Committee at the beginning of her term of office.

Section 4. Each Interest Group shall have one major civic or charitable project during the club year.

## ARTICLE VI

### Committees

Section 1. At the Annual Meeting the President shall appoint the following Standing Committees: Community Service, Program, Communications, Telephone, Ways and Means, Radio and Television, Legislative, Year Book, Calendar, Publication, Press, Visual Education and Awards.

Section 2. The Community Service Committee shall co-operate in movements connected with the general welfare of the community and the Federation.

Section 3. The Program Committee shall arrange programs for the regular monthly meetings of the Club.

Section 4. The Finance Committee shall have supervision of the Finances of the Club; shall direct audit of the books of the Treasurer and any other person having charge of club funds; and shall make a written report thereof at the Annual Meeting.

Section 5. The House Committee shall have supervision of the Club building—rentals, repairs, furnishings and all other matters pertaining to the house.

Section 6. The Grounds Committee shall have supervision of the Club House grounds.

Section 7. The Decorating Committee shall have supervision of decorations for all Club affairs.

Section 8. The Membership Committee shall seek out new members; shall investigate their qualifications; and shall report its recommendations to the Board of Directors.

Section 9. The Press and Publicity Chairman shall give notice of all meetings of the Club and Interest Groups and shall give proper publicity to the various phases of the Club's work.

Section 10. The Telephone Committee shall communicate with Club members at the request of the President.

Section 11. The Ways and Means Committee shall devise methods of raising necessary funds for the betterment of the Club.

Section 12. The Publications Committee shall be responsible for subscriptions to the National Club Magazines and shall give a brief report from these magazines at four meetings during the Club year. At least two news items concerning Club work shall be sent to the State Magazine during the year.

Section 13. The Radio and Television Committee shall present the various club activities and announcements over the radio and television.

Section 14. The Legislative Committee shall study and recommend necessary changes in the Club Constitution and By-Laws and study and keep the Club informed on the State and County Legislative program.

Section 15. The Year Book Committee shall compile and publish a Club Year Book annually.

Section 16. The Calendar Committee shall present a schedule of Club activities to be published in the Year Book and also a monthly calendar to be posted at the Woman's Club.

Section 17. The Press Book Committee shall function throughout the year in collecting material for the Club Press Book, which will be submitted for judging in State Press Book Contest.

Section 18. The Visual Education Chairman shall present the various activities in the field of motion pictures.

Section 19. The Awards Chairman shall review the North Carolina Federation Year Book and acquaint the Club with the various contest and awards offered by the Federation.

Section 20. The Speaker Service Chairman shall contact the Interest Group Chairman at beginning of each Club year and secure from her a list of qualified speakers and topics on which they will speak. Names of speakers and topics shall be mailed to the Federation Division Chairman of the Speaker Service.

Section 21. The Civil Defense Chairman shall direct the activities in this field in accordance with requests from the City Director of Civil Defense.

## **ARTICLE VII**

### **Nomination, Election and Term of Office**

Section 1. The Nominating Committee of five members, two of whom shall be Past Presidents, shall present to the Club at the October meeting names of suitable general officers and after nominations from the floor, if any, the election shall proceed, a majority of the votes cast constituting an election.

Section 2. There shall be an annual election of one group of officers in December of each year, with installation in January.

Section 3. The officers shall be divided into two groups as follows, each group to be elected in alternate years for a term of two years:

- Group 1. President  
Second Vice President  
Recording Secretary  
Assistant Treasurer
- Group 2. First Vice President  
Treasurer  
Assistant Recording Secretary  
Corresponding Secretary

Section 4. The newly elected officers shall assume office at the close of the Annual Meeting.

Section 5. The retiring president shall be an ex-officio member of the Board of Directors for one year without voting power.

Section 6. Each Interest Group shall nominate and elect officers for a two year term. Title of officers shall conform with ARTICLE V, Section 2, of the By-Laws.

## **ARTICLE VIII**

### **Meetings**

Section 1. This Club shall hold regular business meetings on the first Wednesday of each month exclusive of July and August.

Section 2. The meeting in January shall be designated the Annual Meeting at which time annual reports shall be made.

Section 3. The fiscal year shall begin January 1 and end December 31st.

Section 4. The Board of Directors shall meet on the last Thursday in the month.

## **ARTICLE IX**

### **Quorum**

Section 1. Ten members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 2. Forty-two members shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Club for the transaction of business.

## **ARTICLE X**

### **Seal**

The Seal of the Woman's Club shall be circular in form with the words "Woman's Club of Winston-Salem, North Carolina" in the outer rim. In the center shall be the word "Incorporated" and the figures "1923."

## **ARTICLE XI**

### **Parliamentary Authority**

Robert's "Rules of Order" shall be the authority for the conduct of all meetings of the Woman's Club.

## **ARTICLE XII**

These By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting by a two-thirds majority of those present, providing the proposed amendment has been submitted at the previous general meeting.
