WINSTON-SALEM WOMAN'S CLUB

HISTORY

The Winston-Salem Woman's Club was organized in 1919 and joined the State Federation in 1920.

Miss Adelaide Fries and fifteen women representing various clubs and organizations met on April 25, 1919. Mrs. Clarence Johnson was president of the State Federation of Women's Clubs.

On May 7, the first meeting was held in the Board of Trade rooms on Liberty Street. One hundred and seventy-five women were present. The organization was perfected and Mrs. Howard E. Rondthaler was elected President, and Mrs. Henry L. Riggins Vice-President.

Meetings were first held at the YWCA and in the Ballroom at the Robert E. Lee Hotel. Membership grew to 380.

The present club house was purchased in 1925 and opened officially at a vesper service on Sunday, May 24, 1925.

Wednesday was designated as Club Day and the General Meeting was held the first Wednesday, the Garden Department the second, the Art and Literature the fourth and the Music Department the first Thursday.

In later years the Book Review Department, Friday Morning Book Club, Drama Group, Club of Little Gardens, Current Events, Tuesday Afternoon Book Club, Fine Arts, Literary Study Group, Bible group, Poetry Lovers, Art and the American Home, Tuesday Evening Service League, Duplicate Bridge, and Contract Bridge all met at the Club House as part of the Woman's Club.

In 1946 the Woman's Club made its final payment on the Club house. The deed of title is held in trust by the Winston-Salem Foundation.

In 1926 the Junior Woman's Club was organized as a small book club of eight members and was federated in 1929.

Membership in the Junior and Senior Woman's Club is by invitation and the current membership is 240.

The Garden Department and The Thursday Morning Music Club are both members of State and National Federations in their own right.

The Winston-Salem Woman's Club has maintained its membership in the State Federation from 1920-34 and from 1945- . In the 60's the membership was approximately 600.

The Club house is available for meetings, parties, recitals. At the present time the League of Women Voters maintains an office on the second floor. Other rooms are available.

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

Name

This organization shall be known as The Woman's Club of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II

Object

The object of this Club shall be to promote and encourage education, literature, the sciences and arts; to take part in civic affairs affecting the public interest; and to participate in movements connected with the general welfare of the community.

ARTICLE III

Membership

- Section 1. Membership in this Club shall be active and complimentary.
- Section 2. Any woman of Winston-Salem and suburbs shall be eligible for membership. Membership shall be by invitation only.

ARTICLE IV

Interest Groups

The activities of this Club shall be conducted through Interest Groups.

ARTICLE V

Officers

The officers of this Club shall be: President; First Vice President; Second Vice President; Recording Secretary; Assistant Recording Secretary; Corresponding Secretary; Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer.

ARTICLE VI

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors of this Club shall be composed of the Officers, the Chairmen of Standing Committees, the Chairmen of Interest Groups. The President of the Junior Woman's Club shall be a courtesy member of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII

Meetings

The regular meetings of the Woman's Club Board of Directors shall be held monthly except June and July. Regular meetings of the Woman's Club shall be held monthly except July and August.

ARTICLE VIII

Affiliations

- Section 1. This Club is a member of the North Carolina Federation of Women's Clubs.
- Section 2. This Club is a member of the General Federation of Women's Clubs.
- Section 3. The title to the property of this Club is held for the benefit of the Club by the Winston-Salem Foundation.

ARTICLE IX

This Constitution may be amended at any annual meeting by a two-thirds vote of those present, provided notice of the proposed amendment has been submitted in writing at a previous regular meeting of the Club.

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I

Membership

- Section 1. The application of a candidate for membership, signed by herself and two members recommending her, shall be presented to the Board of Directors. If approved by the Board her name shall be submitted to the Club (at a regular meeting) and upon the favorable action of a majority of those present, she shall be admitted to membership. A check for initiation fee and dues must accompany application for membership.
- Section 2. Upon election the prospective member shall be notified by the Membership Chairman. She will be mailed her membership card and upon its presentation shall be admitted to the privileges of Club membership.
- Section 3. Complimentary membership may be presented to the wives of regularly ordained ministers of Winston-Salem and the two women editors of the local press. Dues of the General Club President shall be remitted during her term of office. Membership shall be by invitation only.
- Section 4. A member may withdraw from the Club only through written communication with the Board of Directors.
- Section 5. A member may retain her membership in the Club even though she becomes a non-resident of Winston-Salem, if dues are paid currently. Lapse is dues shall call for cancellation of non-resident membership.
- Section 6. A member of the Junior Woman's Club who is in good standing may be transferred to membership in the Woman's Club upon payment of current dues.
- Section 7. A member may not invite a resident of Winston-Salem or suburbs to any monthly meeting, but may invite a non-resident. A resident may be invited once during the club year to the meetings of the Thursday Morning Music Club, Tuesday Book Club, Poetry Lovers Group, Art and American Home Department, Garden Department and Evening Service League. The bridge groups may invite a non-member substitute once during a series. Penalty for violation of this rule will be: First offense, reprimand by the Executive Board; Second offense, \$5.00 fine; Third offense, suspension from the club.
- Section 8. Any member in good standing in the general club may visit any Interest Group, except the Federated Interest Groups, providing reservation for the luncheon be made in advance with the hostess chairman of that group. A member of the general club may visit a Federated Interest Group only once during the club year.

ARTICLE II

Dues

- Section 1. The annual dues for active membership shall be twenty dollars payable in April.
- Section 2. The initiation fee shall be five dollars.
- Section 3. The fiscal year shall begin June 1 and end May 31.
- Section 4. Members entering the club after December 31 shall be admitted upon payment of \$10.00 and the initiation fee.
- Section 5. A member wishing to resign from the Club must write a letter of resignation to the Club President in order to qualify for reinstatement. A member who has resigned in good standing (i.e. dues paid) may be reinstated within three years without initiation fee upon the payment of her current dues.
- Section 6. Transfer of members in good standing from other Federated Clubs will be accepted without payment of additional dues for the current year.
- Section 7. No member may attend club programs or enjoy the privileges of the club house if her dues are not paid by the June meeting. After that date she will be declared delinquent and her name shall be summarily dropped from the club roster. A member who has been dropped from the club roster for non-payment of dues may again make application for membership. Check for initiation fee and dues for one year must accompany the application for membership.

ARTICLE III

Duties of Officers

Section 1. The President shall preside at all regular meetings of the Club and Board of Directors and shall call all necessary special meetings. She shall, with the approval of the Board, fill vacancies occuring in office, appoint standing and special committees; countersign all orders of the Treasury; present a condensed narrative report of the year's work at the annual meeting; and report on the date designated by N. C. Federation of Women's Clubs, to the District President and to the Federation President, in accordance with instructions. She shall be ex-officio member of all Interest Groups. She shall act as chairman of the Board of Directors and shall submit its annual report. Expenses incurred by the Club President, when representing the Club in her official capacity, shall be reimbursed by the Club Treasurer upon the filing of expense account by the President. Mileage to be allowed on the basis of ten (10) cents per mile.

- Section 2. The First Vice President and, in her absence, the Second Vice President, shall perform all the duties of the President in her absence or dasability.
- Section 3. The Second Vice President shall be Chairman of the Entertainment Committee and shall have charge of all social affairs given by the Club.
- Section 4. The Recording Secretary shall keep in permanent form the minutes of the meetings of the Woman's Club and of the Board of Directors. She shall also keep in separate form all amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws and all important decisions of the Board.
- Section 5. The Assistant Recording Secretary shall perform the duties of the Secretary in her absence and such other duties as may be directed by the Secretary.

Section 6. The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct all correspondence of the Club and Board of Directors.

Section 7. The Treasurer shall collect all dues; hold and pay out all club monies subject to the order of the Board of Directors; issue all membership cards; and serve notice on all delinquents at the proper time. She shall make a report at each regular meeting of the Club and Board of Directors; and at the Annual Meeting, shall render a written report audited by the Finance Committee.

Section 8. The Assistant Treasurer shall perform the duties of the Treasurer in her absence and such other duties as may be directed by the Treasurer.

Section 9. Program Chairman shall be responsible for all programs of the General Club and shall introduce speaker.

ARTICLE IV

Board of Directors

Section 1. Elected Officers, Interest Group Chairmen, Chairmen of Standing Committees shall constitute the Board of Directors. The President of the Junior Woman's Club shall be a Courtesy member of the Board of Directors. The Board shall meet the last Thursday of each month (except June and July) and on special call by the Club President. The President of the General Club shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall transact all business of the ${\tt Club}$ and report its proceedings at the regular ${\tt Club}$ meetings.

Section 3. Any five members of the Board may call the Directors together after the refusal of the President to issue such a call.

ARTICLE V

Interest Groups

Section 1. The work of the Club shall be conducted through Interest Groups. The Interest Groups shall be: Art and American Home Department; Thursday Morning Music Club; Tuesday Book Club; Poetry Lovers Group; Evening Service League; Duplicate Bridge and Contract Bridge.

Section 2. The Officers of each Interest Group shall be: Chairman; Vice-Chairman; Secretary; Treasurer. Term of office will be for two years.

Section 3. Each Interest Group Chairman will appoint a nominating Committee at the beginning of her term of office.

Section 4. Each Interest Group shall have one major civic or charitable project during the club year.

ARTICLE VI

Committees

Section 1. At the Annual Meeting the President shall appoint the following Standing Committees: Telephone, Ways and Means, Legislative, Year Book, Calendar, Publication, Press and Awards.

Section 2. The Program Committee shall arrange programs for the regular monthly meetings of the Club.

Section 3. The Finance Committee shall have supervision of the Finances of the Club; shall direct audit of the books of the Treasurer and any other person having charge of club funds; and shall make a written report thereof at the Annual Meeting.

Section 4. The House Committee shall have supervision of the Club building - rentals, repairs, furnishings and all other matters pertaining to the house. The Committee shall keep an up to date inventory of all Club property. The House Committee shall be a committee of three members. Exofficio members shall be the Club Treasurer and the Finance Chairman.

Section 5. The Grounds Committee shall have supervision of the Club House grounds.

Section 6. The Decorating Committee shall have supervision of decorations for all Club affairs.

Section 7. The Membership Committee shall seek out new members; shall investigate their qualifications; and shall report its recommendations to the Board of Directors.

Section 8. The Press and Publicity Chairman shall give notice of all meetings of the Club and shall give proper publicity to the various phases of the Club's work.

Section 9. The Telephone Committee shall communicate with Club members at the request of the President.

Section 10. The Ways and Means Committee shall devise methods of raising necessary funds for the betterment of the Club.

Section 11. The Publications Chairman shall be responsible for subscriptions to the National Club Magazines and shall give a brief report from these magazines at four meetings during the Club year. At least two news items concerning Club work shall be sent to the State Magazine during the year.

Section 12. The Legislative Chairman shall study and recommend necessary changes in the Club Constitution and By-Laws and study and keep the Club informed on the State and County Legislative program.

Section 13. The Year Book Committee shall compile and publish a Club Year Book annually.

Section 14. The Calendar Chairman shall present a schedule of Club activities to be published in the Year Book and also a monthly calendar to be posted at the Woman's Club.

Section 15. The Press Book committee shall function throughout the year in collecting material for the Club Press Book, which will be submitted for judging in the State Press Book Contest.

Section 16. The Parliamentarian shall direct procedures at Executive Board meetings and General Meetings.

Section 17. The Public Affairs Chairman shall correlate the activities of this department through the Division Chairmen of Crime Prevention and Law Observance, Citizenship, Safety, National and Civil Defense, Veterans Affairs, Geronotology, Savings Bonds, Community Affairs and Health.

Section 18. The Education Chairman shall correlate the activities of this Department through the Division Chairman of Communications. Radio and Television, Continuing Education, ESO, Library Services, Public Education and Scholarships.

Section 19. The Conservation Chairman shall correlate the activities of this Department through the Division Chairmen of Gardens and Beautification, Minerals and Wild Life, Timber Resources and Park Areas and Water and Soil.

Section 20. The International Affairs Chairman shall correlate the activities of this Department through the Division Chairmen of International Projects, Study of Areas and United States and Specialized Agencies.

Section 21. The Home Life Chairman shall correlate the activities of this Department through the Division Chairmen of Family Life and Religion, Helping Hand, Youth and Birthday Remembrance, Family Economics and Home Management.

Section 22. The Fine Arts Chairman shall correlate the activities of this Department through the Division Chairman of Music Crafts, Literature and Drama, Art and Ten Penny Art Fund.

ARTICLE VII

Nomination, Election and Term of Office

Section 1. The Nominating Committee of three mombers, one of whom shall be Past President, shall present to the Club at the March meeting names of suitable general officers and after nominations from the floor, if any, the election shall proceed, a majority of the votes cast constituting an election.

Section 2. There shall be an annual election of one group of officers in March of each year, with installation in June.

Section 3. The officers shall be divided into two groups as follows, each group to be elected in alternate years for a term of two years.

- Group 1. President
 Second Vice President
 Recording Secretary
 Assistant Treasurer
- Group 2. First Vice President
 Treasurer
 Assistant Recording Secretary
 Corresponding Secretary

Section 4. The newly elected officers shall assume office at the close of the Annual Meeting.

Section 5. The retiring president shall be an ex-officio member of the Board of Directors for one year without voting power.

Section 6. Each Interest Group shall nominate and elect officers for a two year term. Title of officers shall conform with ARTICLE V, Section 2, of the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII

Meetings

Section 1. This Club shall hold regular business meetings on the first Thursday of each month exclusive of July and August.

Section 2. The meeting in June shall be designated the Annual Meeting at which time annual reports shall be made.

Section 3. The fiscal year shall begin June 1 and end May 31.

Section 4. The Board of Directors shall meet on the first Thursday in the month before the General Meeting.

ARTICLE IX

Quorum

Section 1. Ten members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 2. Thirty-five members shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Club for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE X

Seal

The Seal of the Woman's Club shall be circular in form with the words "Woman's Club of Winston-Salem, North Carolina" in the outer rim. In the center shall be the word "Incorporated" and the figures "1923."

ARTICLE XI

Parliamentary Procedure

Robert's "Rules of Order" shall be the authority for the conduct of all meetings of the Woman's Club.

ARTICLE XII

These By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting by a two-thirds majority of those present, providing the proposed amendment has been submitted at the previous general meeting.
