#### MY CREED

#### CLUB HISTORY

May 7, 1977, marked the fifty-eighth birthday of our Club, since it was duly organized in 1919, when Mrs. Howard Rondthaler was elected the first president by one hundred sixty women who signed the membership roster in a large room over L. B. Brickerstein's Store on Liberty Street just below Third Street.

The seven original departments of the Winston-Salem Woman's Club as designated at this organizational meeting were: <u>Literature and Art; Education and Library Extension; Social Service; Civics; Health; Home Economics; and Music.</u>

By the end of the second Club year, the membership had grown to 321. A headline in the local Sentinel that year read, Daily Question Being Asked: "HOW CAN ONE GET MEMBERSHIP IN THE WOMAN'S CLUB?"

Affiliation with the State Federation was immediate and the new Club aligned itself with thirty-one movements in the city and state, some of which included the organization of the Woman's Auxiliary of the American Legion; the establishment of Probation Officers (then unheard of); the establishment of a cooperative produce market; a flower show; the beginnings of the County Home Demonstrator; a Story Hour at the Public Library; and the planting of a Memorial Highway between Winston-Salem and High Point with Norway Maples, Crepe Myrtle, and roses, some of which still survive.

Early meetings were held wherever space was available as the membership during the first four years soared to 555. During this time the venture to secure a clubhouse was started and our present one was purchased in 1924 for the staggering sum of \$67,500.00. The ensuing years were dark and bleak for the Club. Many members dropped out, tired of struggling, and the end did seem to be

near. In 1931, six past-presidents banded together to save the Club and the clubhouse. Through COOPERATION (the keynote to success) the mortgage was burned October 2, 1946. This is the heritage of the members of the Winston-Salem Woman's Club. May it live on and be cherished forever by all!

#### OUR OBJECT

"The object of this Club shall be to promote and encourage education, literature, the sciences and arts; to take part in civic affairs affecting the public interest; and to participate in movements connected with the general welfare of the community."
